GENERAL

1. REPORTING REQUIREMENT

This procedure sets out the details for the quantity of bulk oil to be reported by the Funding Member in accordance to the requirements of the Agreement between the Funding Member and WCMRC.

The Funding Member is to report the applicable quantity of bulk oil for their operations in the British Columbia and Yukon Region, consisting of the Province of British Columbia and the Yukon Territory.

2. USE OF INFORMATION

WCMRC shall use the information supplied by the Funding Member to calculate the payment due and payable by the Funding Members to WCMRC for the contracted services provided by WCMRC for the preceding calendar year.

3. CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION

The information provided by the Funding Member will be treated in a confidential manner and its use will be restricted to the purposes indicated in item 2 above.

4. CALCULATION OF THE QUANTITY OF BULK OIL TO BE REPORTED

The calculation for the quantity of bulk oil to be reported is shown in Attachment 1.

5. PRODUCTS FOR WHICH QUANTITY OF BULK OIL IS TO BE REPORTED

The oil products for which the quantity of bulk oil is to be reported are shown in Attachment 2

6. REPORTING FORMS

The form for reporting the quantities of bulk oil is provided in Attachment 3

ATTACHMENT 1

CALCULATION OF QUANTITY OF BULK OIL TO BE REPORTED

DEFINITIONS

Funding Member – Party that has contracted with WCMRC to provide emergency response services.

Funding Member Terminal (FMT) – The terminal operated or used by the Funding Member at which the applicable quantity of bulk oil product is loaded.

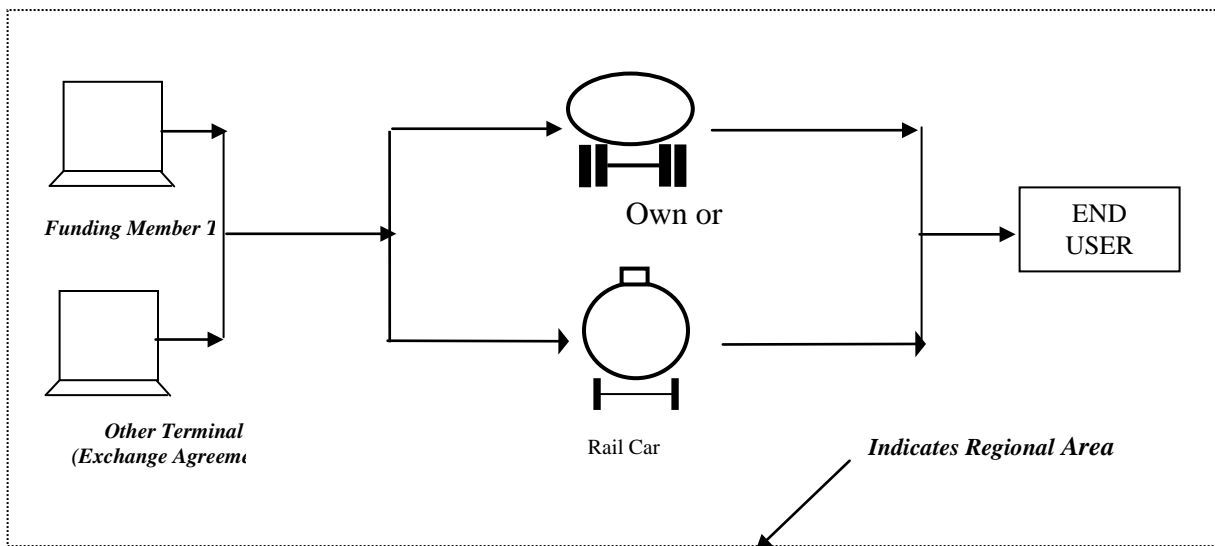
Funding Member Carrier (FMC) – The tank truck or rail car owned or contracted by the Funding Member to transport the applicable quantity of bulk oil to the end user.

End User – The location where the applicable quantity of bulk oil loaded at Funding Member Terminal is unloaded.

Regional Area – The geographic area in which the Funding Member loads the applicable quantity of bulk oil.
i.e. British Columbia and Yukon

Case 1 – Product is loaded and unloaded within a Regional Area By Funding Member



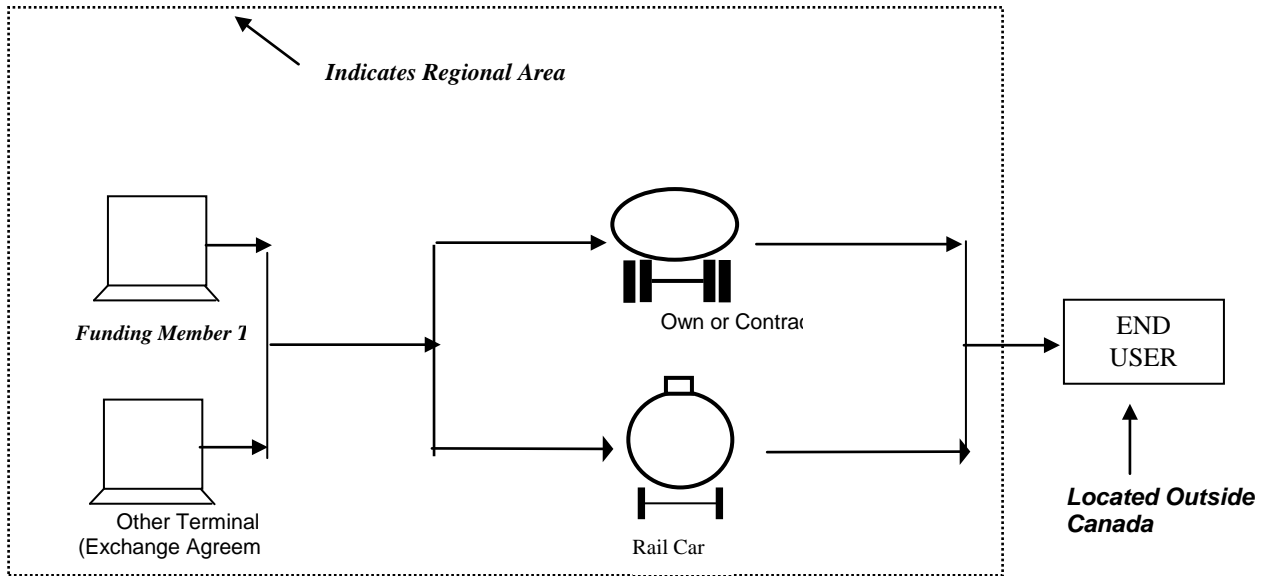

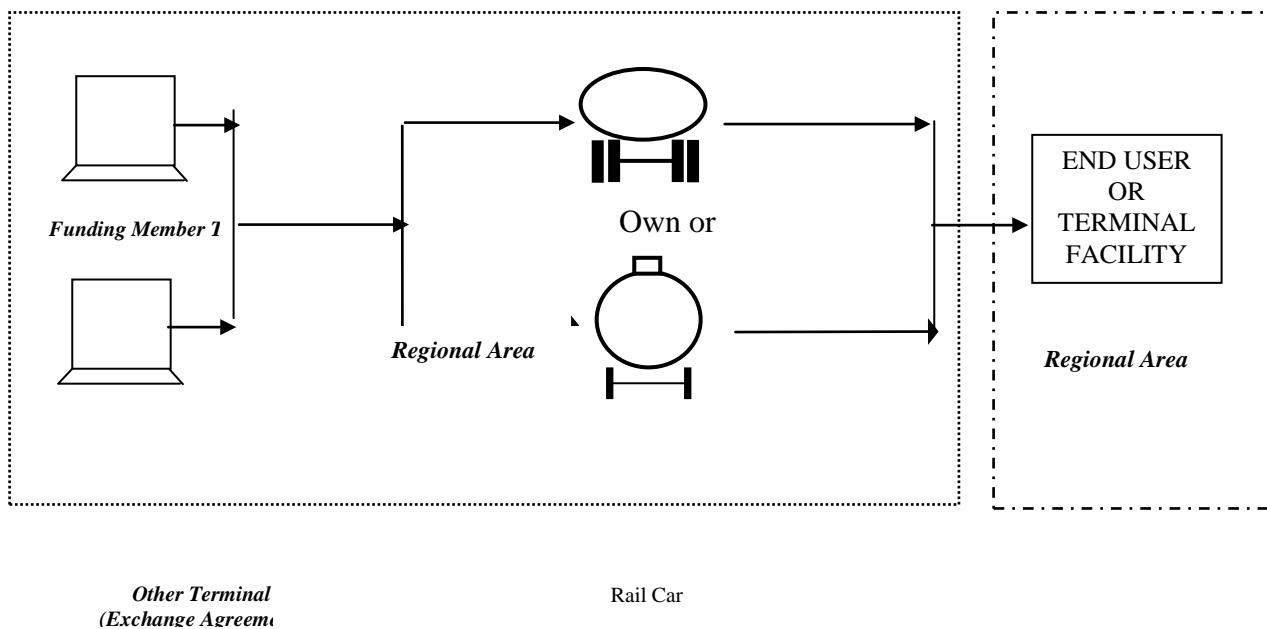
Case 2 – Product is loaded by Funding Member within a Regional Area and unloaded to End User located outside of Canada (Export)



REPORTING REQUIREMENT – CASE 2

Report for each Regional Area the total quantity of bulk oil loaded at Funding Member Terminals and if applicable, other terminals under an exchange agreement, that is subsequently unloaded at End Users outside Canada.

Case 3 – Product is loaded by Funding Member within Regional Area and is unloaded to End User or a terminal facility in another Regional Area.

Report for each Regional Area the total quantity of bulk oil loaded at Funding Member Terminals and if applicable, other terminals under an exchange agreement, that is subsequently unloaded at End Users or terminal facilities in another Regional Area.
